Three Types of Assessment

o Obtrusive

 Formalized, interrupt the normal flow of activity in the classroom -pencil/paper tests, projects, quiz



o Unobtrusive

Informal, do not interrupt the normal flow

 observations, Listening for key ideas, watching for key actions or processes

Student Generated

 Students generate their own ideas to show their current level of knowledge or skill.
