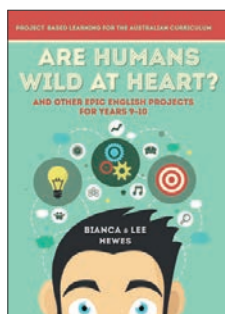
## SATURDAY 19 MAY
