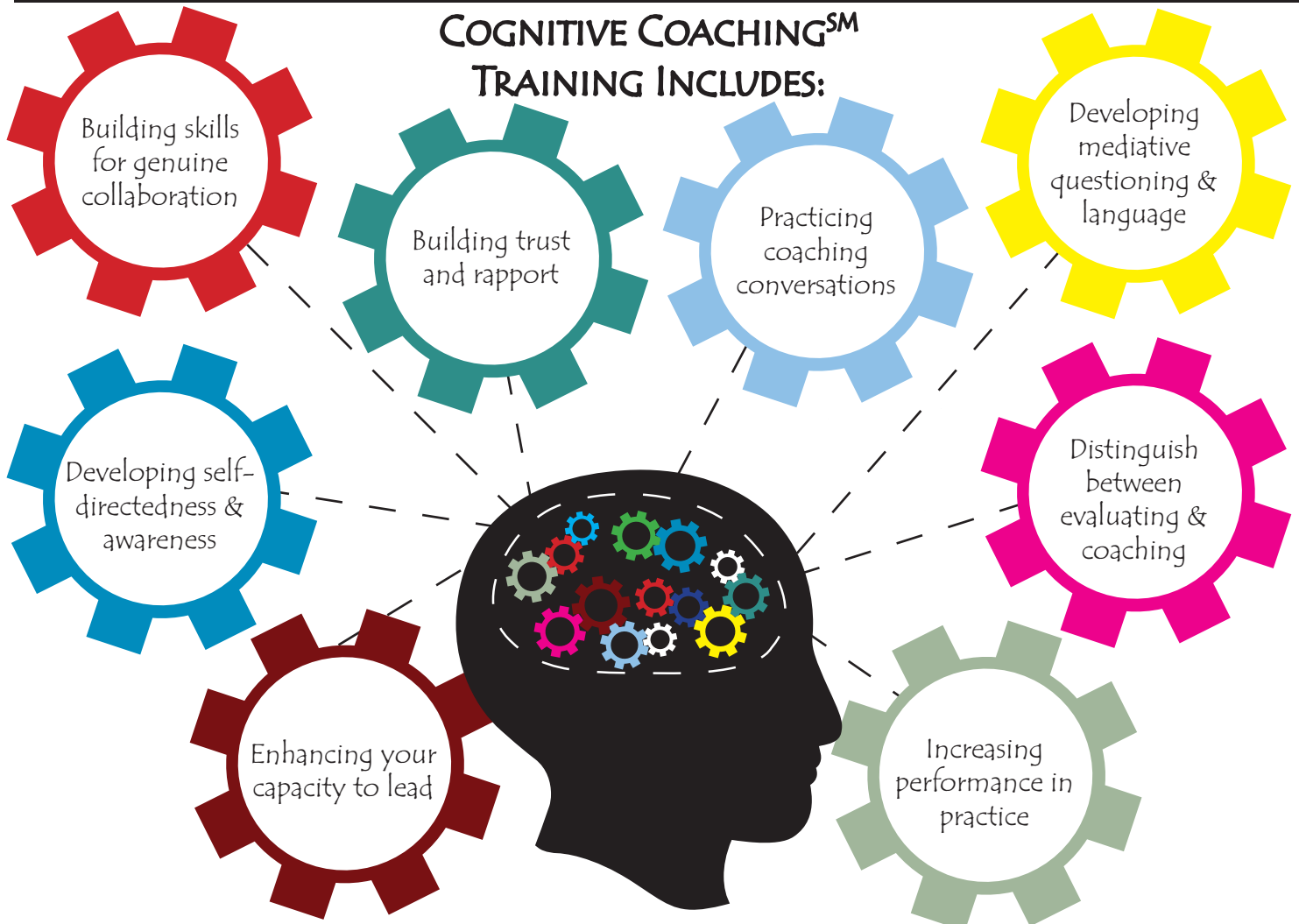

Cognitive CoachingSM was co-developed by Art Costa and Robert Garmston, who define it as “a set of strategies, a way of thinking and a way of working that invites self and others to shape and reshape their thinking and problem solving capacity” (Center for Cognitive Coaching; www.cognitivecoaching.com). Cognitive CoachingSM training focuses on the maps and tools needed to mediate another’s thinking. The metaphor of maps and tools is used to indicate the dynamic, individualised way in which coaching takes place.

The main tools of Cognitive CoachingSM are: rapport, mediative questioning, response behaviours, pacing and leading. The training focuses on learning these tools and using them with the maps. A major focus of the training is trust and rapport.

The mission of Cognitive Coaching is to produce **self-directed** persons with the **cognitive capacity** for high performance **both independently and as members of a community**. (A. Costa and R.
