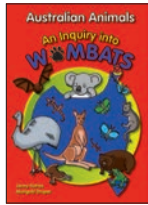

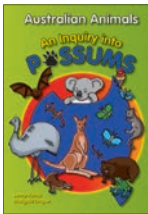
AUSTRALIAN ANIMALS: AN INQUIRY INTO WOMBATS

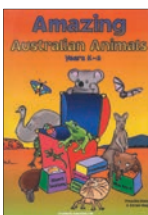


A IS FOR ANIMALS

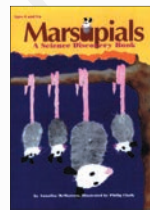
LOOKING FOR ANIMALS

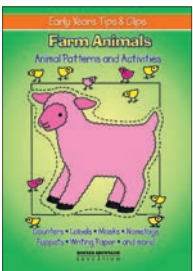
SUPER DUPER SCIENCE: PUSSY CAT, PUSSY CAT: YRS 1-3

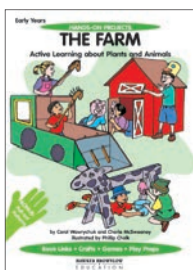

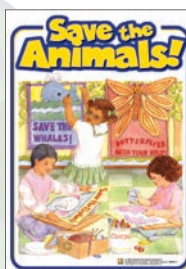
