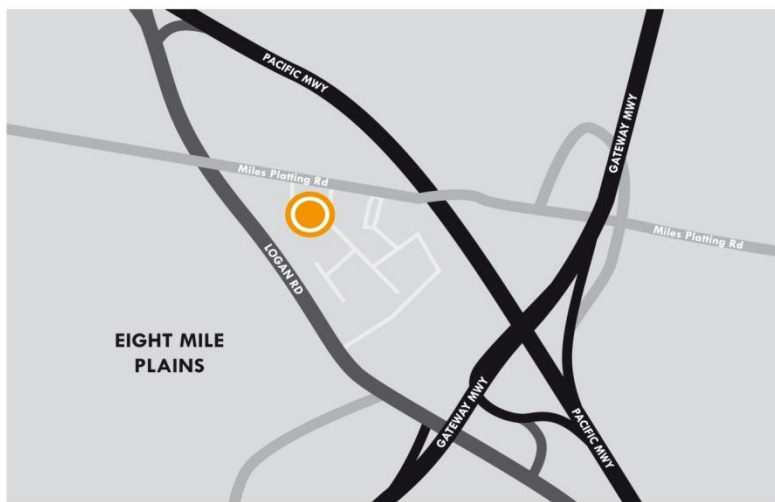

LOCATION

Nestled between the Gateway Motorway, Pacific Highway, Logan Road and the Logan Motorway our Centre boasts free on-site parking, and easy access by road or public transport.

Below is a map of our location:



The Brisbane Airport is approximately 20 minutes along the Gateway Motorway. Please note that a toll applies on the Gateway Bridge.

The CBD is approximately 15 minutes drive along the Pacific Motorway, and the Gold Coast is approximately 40 minutes via the Pacific or Gateway Motorways.

Ipswich is 40 minutes away via the Logan Motorway. Please note that a toll applies on the Logan Motorway.

TRANSPORT

Driving:

If you are planning to drive to the BTP Conference & Exhibition Centre:

Heading Southbound:

- From the city travel southbound along the Pacific Motorway take the Logan Road exit (Exit 14). Turn right at Logan Road, left at Miles Platting Road and take the first right hand turn into Clunies Ross Court where you will find the BTP Conference & Exhibition Centre straight ahead.
- From the Gateway Motorway heading southbound, take the Eight Mile Plains exit (Exit 88). Turn right onto Miles Platting Road. Turn left into McKechnie Drive and take the first right into Clunies Ross Court where you will find the BTP Conference & Exhibition Centre straight ahead.

Heading Northbound:

- From the Gateway Motorway heading northbound, take the Eight Mile Plains exit (Exit 88). Turn right onto Miles Platting Road. Turn left into McKechnie Drive and take the first right into Clunies Ross Court where you will find the BTP Conference & Exhibition Centre straight ahead.
- Travelling northbound towards the City on the Pacific Motorway, take the Logan Road Exit (Exit 14). Turn left at Logan Road, left at Miles Platting Road and take the first right hand turn into Clunies Ross Court where you will find the BTP Conference & Exhibition Centre straight ahead.

Please arrive early to secure a car parking space.

Please note that there are a number of parking bays marked "Reserved". These are for the office tenants in the Centre. Parking in these reserved bays is strictly prohibited, and vehicles will be towed away at the owner's expense.

Public Transport:

If you are planning to take public transport to the BTP Conference & Exhibition Centre, the Eight Mile Plains Busway station is an easy 5 minute walk down Miles Platting Road. Take a left into McKechnie Drive at the lights, and right into Clunies Ross Court. Towards the end of Clunies Ross Court you will find the BTP Conference & Exhibition Centre straight ahead.

PARKING

The BTP Conference & Exhibition Centre offers ample parking for delegates. Parking fees are \$5.00 per day Monday to Friday (weekends no charge). Conference parking bays are located to the front and right hand side of the BTP Conference & Exhibition Centre.

Please arrive early to secure a car parking space.

Please note that there are a number of parking bays marked "Reserved". These are for the office tenants in the Centre. Parking in these reserved bays is strictly prohibited, and vehicles will be towed away at the owner's expense.

DISABLED ACCESS

The BTP Conference & Exhibition Centre caters for the disabled.

Disabled parking bays are located at the front of the building, with an access ramp adjacent to the front stairs. The disabled toilet is located beside the Ladies Toilets.

Disabled access is throughout the Centre's Atrium, Auditoriums and adjoining Pinstripe Café. However access to the Everest Boardroom and Empire Room is via stairs only and therefore delegates with mobility issues may not be able to access these rooms easily.
