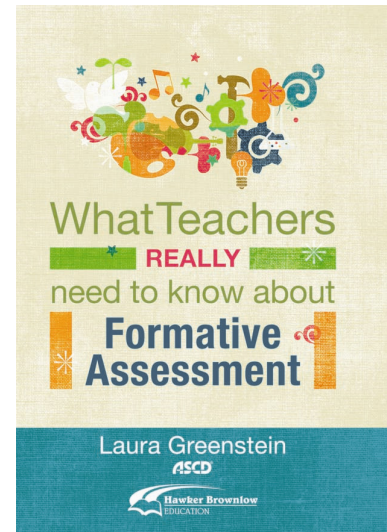


What Teachers Really Need to Know About Formative Assessment
