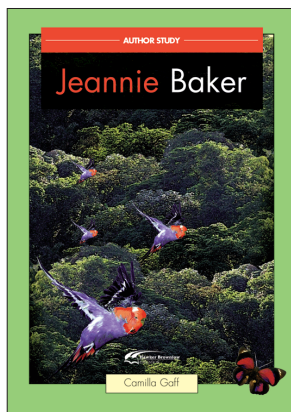


# Literature Unit: Author Study - Focus on Jeannie Baker

Each book has its own section with a summary, and unit writing and comprehension activities that build on students' understanding of both the books themselves and the deeper themes they raise about Australia and our environment.
