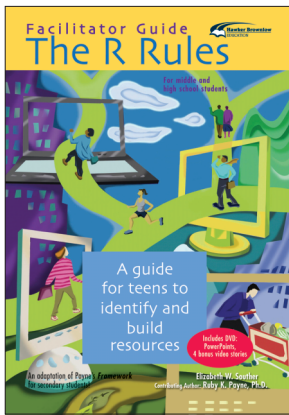


Facilitator Guide: The R Rules
