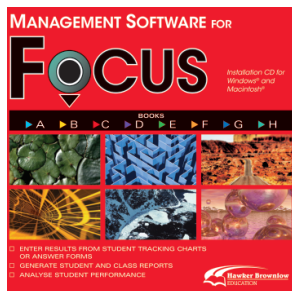

You may then view individual student reports: Teacher Assessments 1, 2 and 3 from the FOCUS Teacher Guides; and an individual student Reading Strategies Report, showing all books completed. Teacher Assessment 3 may be printed as a 'parent letter'. Two Class Reports are also available.

### SYSTEM REQUIREMENTS

Windows - Pentium III 500MHz or higher; Windows 2000 (Service Pack 4), XP (Service Pack 2); 256 MB RAM; 40 MB free hard disk space.

Macintosh - PowerPC G3, G4 or G5 processor; OS X 10.3.9 or higher; 256 MB RAM; 40 MB free hard disk space. Will run on Apple computers with Intel processors.

Additional requirements: Adobe Acrobat Reader required to view the ReadMe file from within the software. If you do not have Adobe Acrobat Reader, you can download it for free at [www.adobe.com](http://www.adobe.com). The ReadMe file is also available as an HTML file on the Installation CD.

To export and view student records in Excel, you must have Microsoft Excel installed on your computer.
