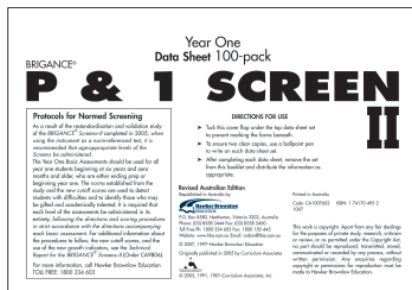

Summary:

The Year One Basic Assessments should be used for children aged 6 years to 6 years and 11 months. The norms established from the study and the new cutoff scores are used to detect children with difficulties and to identify those who may be gifted and academically talented. It is required that all basic assessments at the Year One level be administered, following the directions and scoring procedures in strict accordance with the directions accompanying each basic assessment. The Year One Data Sheets are for use with the P&I Screen–II. These duplicate carbonless sheets are designed for recording the child's personal information; recording screening responses and observations and calculating scores; and communicating results with staff and parents.
