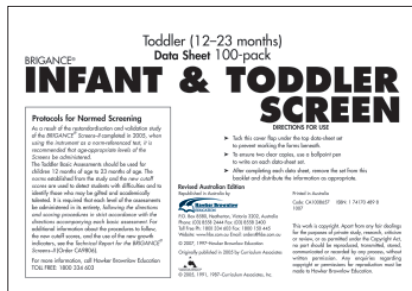

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Age Range: Toddler, 12 months–23 months

Key Selling Points:

- Screening can be accomplished quickly and easily; 12–15 minutes per child
- Assessments are curriculum-referenced, norm-referenced and criterion-referenced
- Screening will be a successful experience for most students
- Duplication of assessments can be avoided

Summary:

The Toddler Basic Assessments should be used for children aged 1 year to 1 year and 11 months. The norms established from the study and the new cutoff scores are used to detect children with difficulties and to identify those who may be gifted and academically talented. It is required that all basic assessments at the Toddler Child level be administered, following the directions and scoring procedures in strict accordance with the directions accompanying each basic assessment.

The Toddler Child Data Sheets are for use with the Brigance Infant and Toddler Screen. These duplicate carbonless sheets are designed for recording the child's personal information; recording screening responses and observations and calculating scores; and communicating results with staff and parents.
