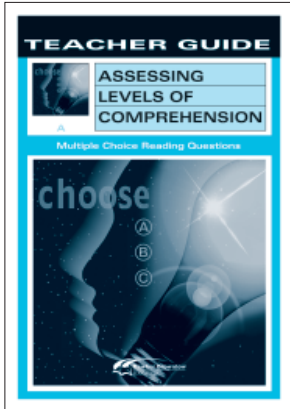

### Summary:

Assessing Levels of Comprehension is a diagnostic reading series that gives students practice in answering reading questions at four levels of comprehension – FIND IT, CONNECT IT, ADD TO IT and GO BEYOND IT. The levels of comprehension relate to the levels of thinking used to attain answer information ranging from the literal to the abstract. ALC allows students the opportunity for self-assessment, while it allows teachers the opportunity to identify and assess students' level of mastery at each of the four levels of comprehension. Assessing Levels of Comprehension helps both students and teachers meet their reading challenges at all levels.
