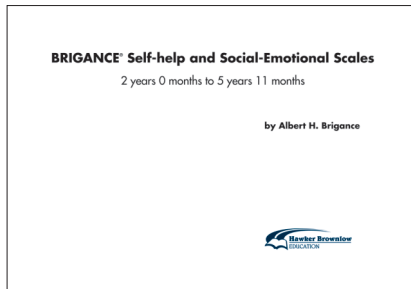

Summary:

These scales can be used as a means of gaining a broader understanding of a child's developmental level and, if needed, to derive standardised scores in these two areas. Standard score, percentile and age equivalent can therefore be determined by adhering to the directions given, forming a useful and highly valuable picture of a child's development.
