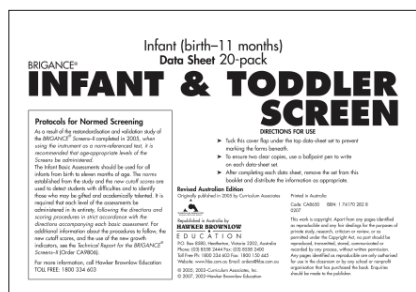

Summary:

The Infant Data Sheets are for use with the Infant and Toddler Screen. These duplicate carbonless sheets are designed for recording the child's personal information; recording screening responses and observations and calculating scores; and communicating results with staff and parents.
