The Inventory of Early Development-II includes over 200 developmental, readiness and early academic skills assessments in 11 major skill areas: perambulatory motor skills and behaviours, gross-motor skills and behaviours, fine-motor skills and behaviours, self-help skills, speech and language skills, general knowledge and comprehension, social and emotional development, readiness, basic reading skills, manuscript writing and basic maths.

The Class Record Book allows assessors to record criterion-referenced and standardised results for 15 students in a matrix grid allowing for easy instructional grouping and planning.
