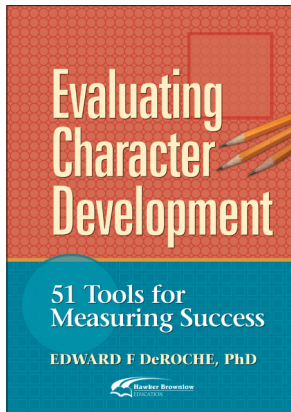


Evaluating Character Development: 51 Tools for Measuring Success
