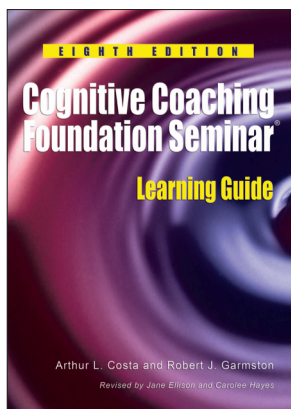


Cognitive Coaching Foundation Seminar Learning Guide, 8th Edition
