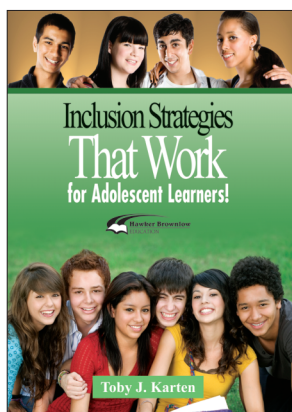


# Inclusion Strategies that Work for Adolescent Learners
