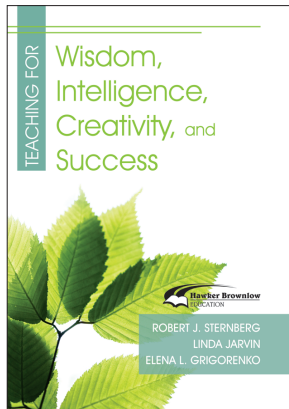


Teaching for Wisdom, Intelligence, Creativity, and Success
