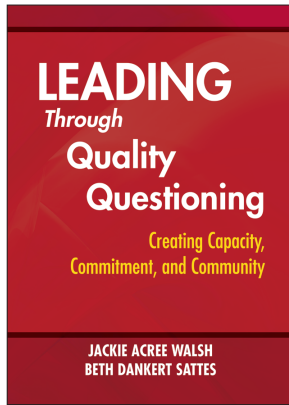


Leading Through Quality Questioning: Creating Capacity, Commitment, and Community

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Summary:

Quality questioning is a process for engaging individuals in reflection, critical thinking and collaboration. The authors demonstrate how questions, not answers, drive school improvement and growth for a learning community. This handbook for school and regional leaders applies the principles of the best-selling book *Quality Questioning* to four critical leadership functions: maximising individual and organisational capacity; mobilising individuals and groups to build ownership and commitment across a community; mediating conflict by helping individuals find common ground and focus on shared purpose; and monitoring progress towards identified goals.
