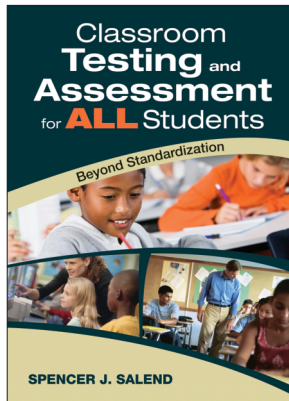


Classroom Testing and Assessment for ALL Students: Beyond Standardization
