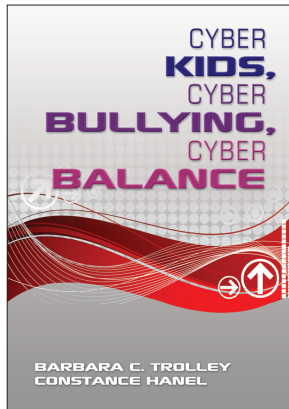


Cyber Kids, Cyber Bullying, Cyber Balance
