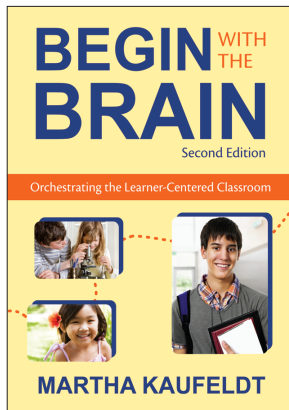


Begin With the Brain: Orchestrating the Learner-Centered Classroom, Second Edition
