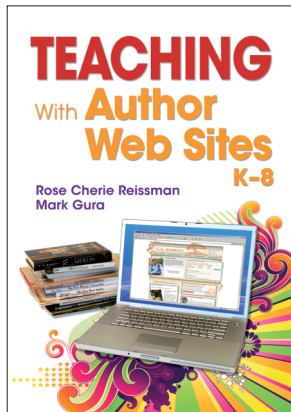


# Teaching with Author Websites, P-8
