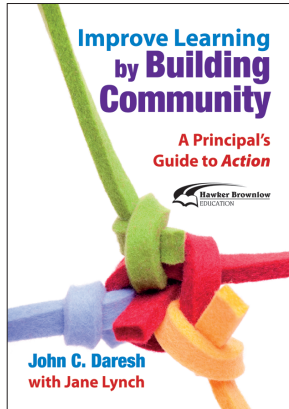


# Improve Learning by Building Community
