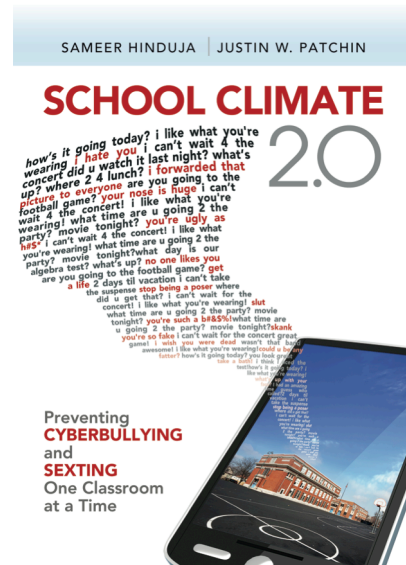


School Climate 2.0: Preventing Cyberbullying and Sexting One Classroom at a Time

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Summary:

Bullying is not new, but its venues have expanded to include social media and mobile phones. When students receive hurtful, threatening or sexually explicit electronic messages, it affects their ability to concentrate on schoolwork. Renowned cyberbullying experts Sameer Hinduja and Justin W.
