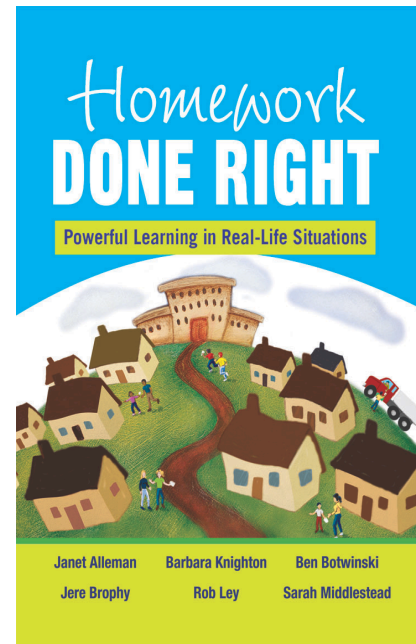


Homework Done Right: Powerful Learning in Real-Life Situations
