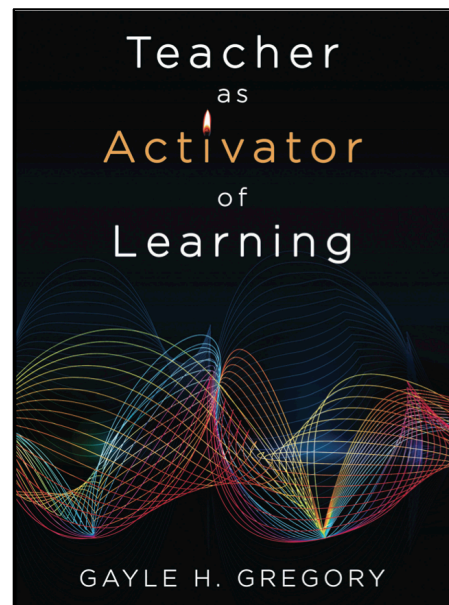


Teacher as Activator of Learning
