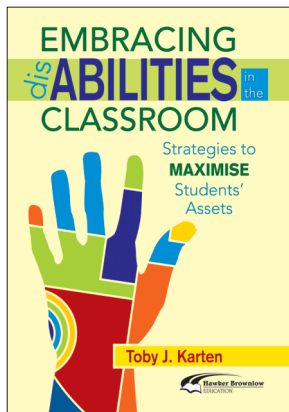


Embracing Disabilities in the Classroom
