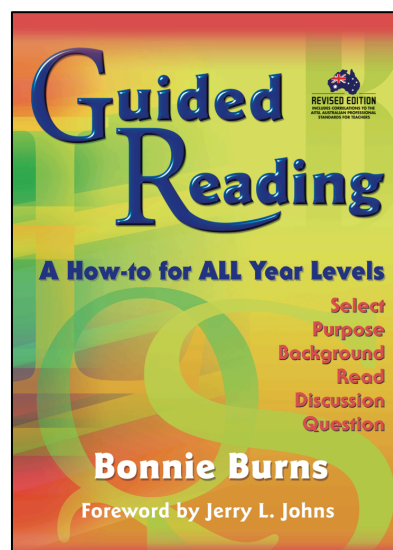

Summary:

Learning how to read doesn't end at Year 3, Year 5 or even Year 8. Guided reading strategies have traditionally been used with younger readers, but for the first time author Bonnie Burns shows teachers how to use these successful strategies for students of all ages.

Guided reading should be at the core of any literacy curriculum. Burns demonstrates that the “guided reading technique” enables teachers to build bridges between direct instruction and independent reading. *Guided Reading: A How-to for All Year Levels* focuses each chapter on a different year level ranging from Foundation to Year 12, and includes think-aloud strategies, visualisation and reciprocal reading.
