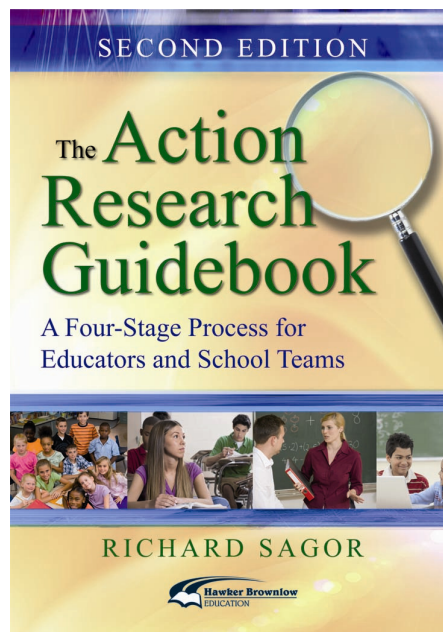


The Action Research Guidebook
