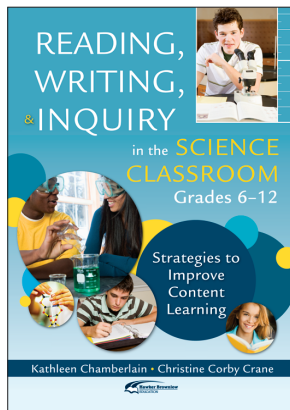


# Reading, Writing and Inquiry in the Science Classroom, Grades 6-12
