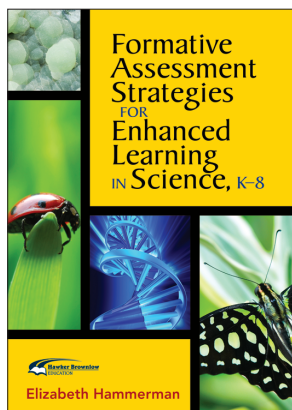


Formative Assessment Strategies for Enhanced Learning in Science, K-8
