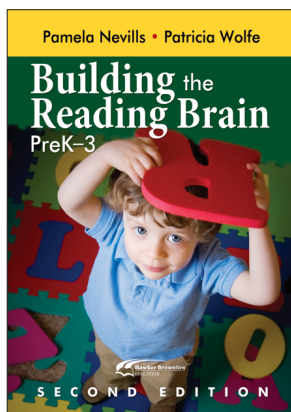


# Building the Reading Brain, Second Edition
