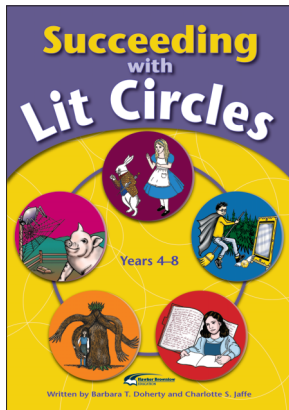


Succeeding with Lit Circles
