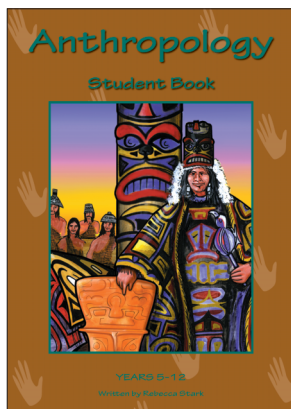

Summary:

Students are presented with background information to provide a general understanding of the subjects. Mind-stimulating activities, based upon information given and outside research, encourage critical and creative thinking. These self-directed activities emphasise higher-level thinking skills and are keyed to Bloom's Revised Taxonomy. Students learn about human development and about the physical, social and cultural development of various societies. Concepts of social organisation are introduced: kinship groups, residence patterns, associations, marriage, etc. Also covered are political organisation, ideology and religion.
