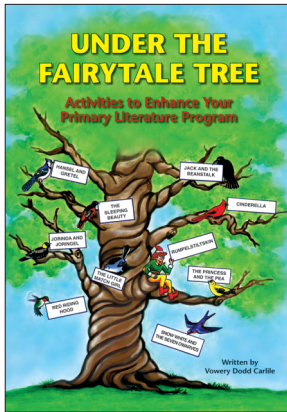


Under the Fairytale Tree

Summary:

Under the Fairytale Tree uses ten popular fairytales to build important reading and comprehension skills by teaching children to read, think and write – critically and creatively. Each unit begins with a summary of the story and questions based upon the six levels of Bloom's Revised Taxonomy of Educational Objectives: Remembering, Understanding, Applying, Analysing, Evaluating and Creating. These are followed by independent project ideas developed to encourage creative thinking and writing. The fairytales covered in Under the Fairytale Tree are: Snow White and the Seven Dwarves, Sleeping Beauty, Red Riding Hood, The Princess and the Pea, Jack and the Beanstalk, Rumpelstiltskin, Cinderella, Jorinda and Joringel, Hansel and Gretel and The Little Match Girl.
