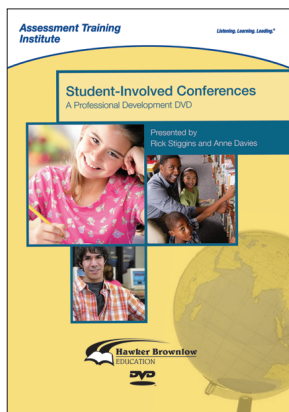


# Student-Involved Conferences
