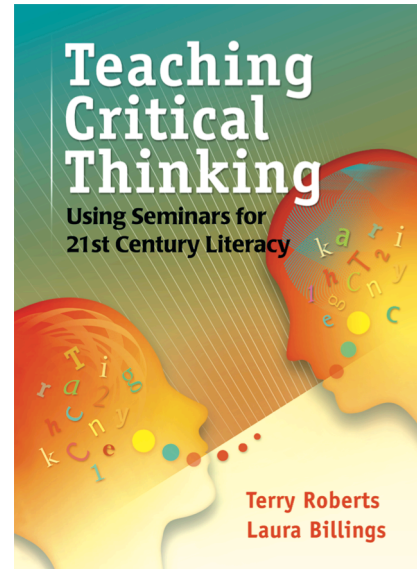


# Teaching Critical Thinking: Using Seminars for 21<sup>st</sup> Century Literacy
