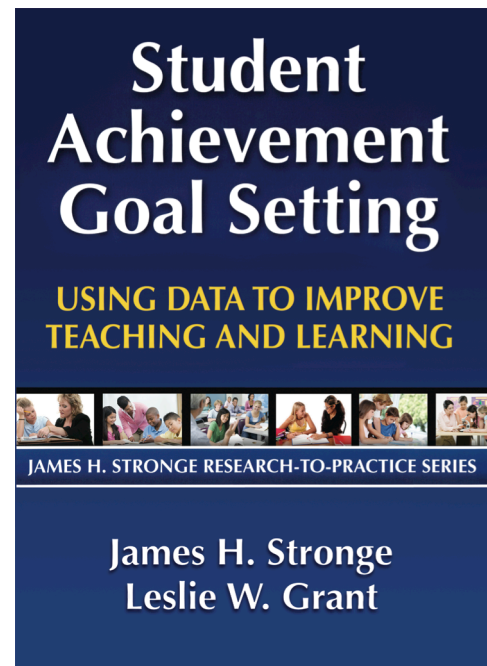


Student Achievement Goal Setting: Using Data to Improve Teaching and Learning
