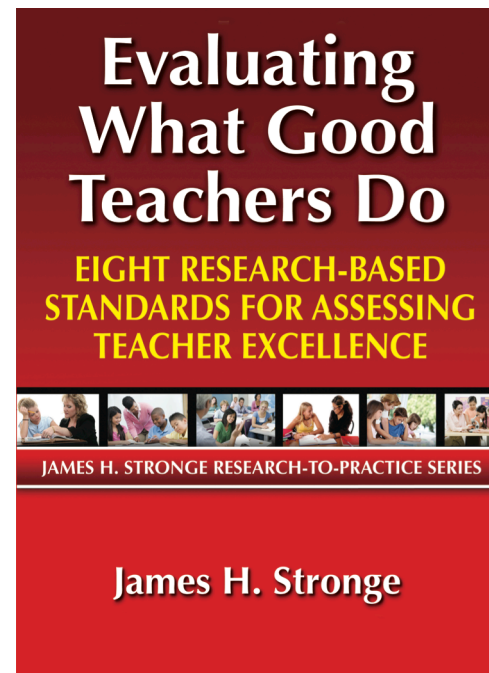


# Evaluating What Good Teachers Do: Eight Research-Based Standards for Assessing Teacher Excellence
