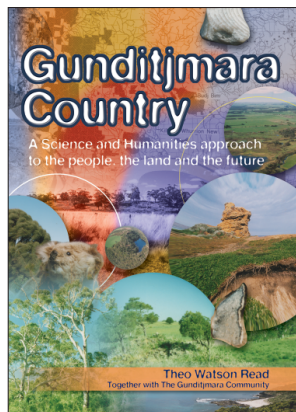

Featuring photographs, historical and cultural information, as well as information about the lands of the Gunditjmara, this resource spans geography, science, history, cultural studies and much more for middle- to upper-secondary students. The introduction provides a useful guide to implementing this program of study in your school and includes feedback from teachers involved in the trialling the material.
