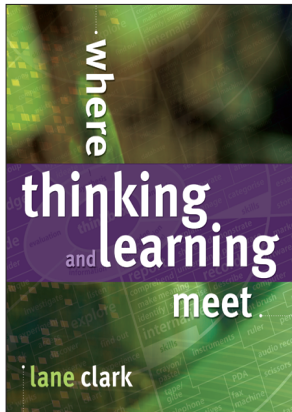


Where Thinking and Learning Meet
