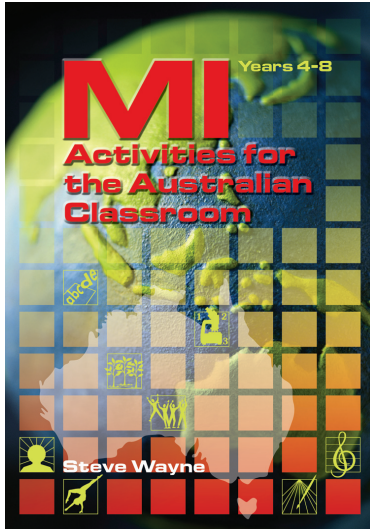

Summary:

The units of work contained in this book have been developed to meet the needs of different types of learners through the use of Gardner's theory of Multiple Intelligences. They reflect the belief that all children are talented in their own way and that the most important mission of teaching is to nurture the individual abilities and personal development of each child.

All of the units begin with a set of background questions that contain core information on the topic of study. This knowledge base is then expanded with eight ways to further research the topic, giving students a choice of using the different intelligences. Also included in the book is an overview of assessment strategies including sample checklists and rubrics.

MI Activities for the Australian Classroom covers a huge range of topics including: aboriginal studies, explorers and colonisation, the environment, political and economic systems, the media, inventions and heroes among others.
