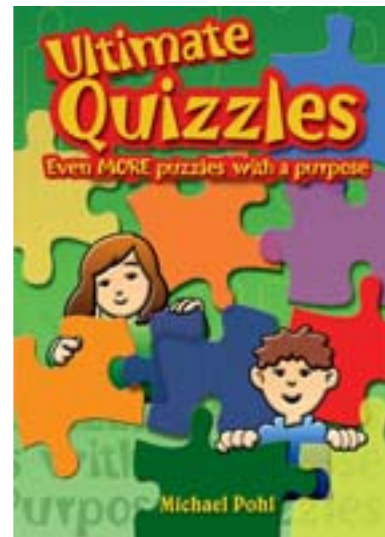

This book:

- is made up of activities that aim to stimulate the brain and develop high-order thinking skills
- requires students to use analytical, critical, and creative thinking to solve puzzles
- includes a note to the teacher to help explain some of the “keys” to unlocking puzzles
- includes an answer key and blank pages for students to create their own *Quizzes*.

Summary:

Quizzes are designed to provide the stimulation required by the brain to think better. They challenge and extend the way you think, in a way that is both relaxing and enjoyable. Those teachers familiar with Bloom’s Taxonomy of Educational Objectives will be aware of the need to teach the skills of analytical, critical and creative thinking.

This book provides practise for solving puzzles to assist in the development of analytical thought processes – the ability to examine discrete parts of something in order to better understand the whole. The book also encourages critical thinking as students decide between alternatives and arrive at a defensible solution. Teachers can assist by drawing attention to the strategies that are the “keys” to unlocking the puzzles.
