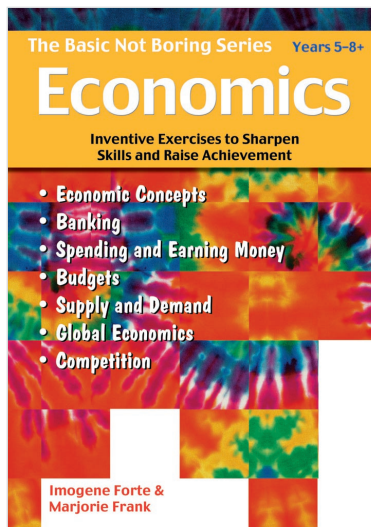

## Summary:
