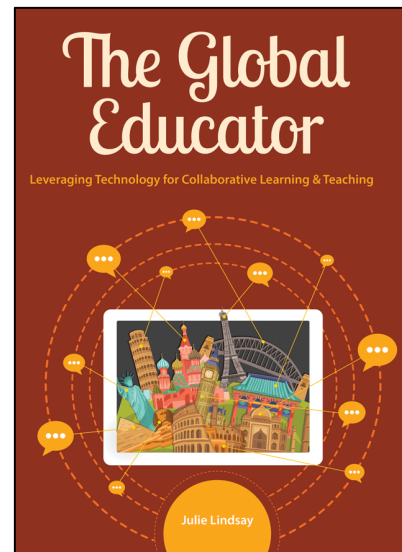


The Global Educator:
