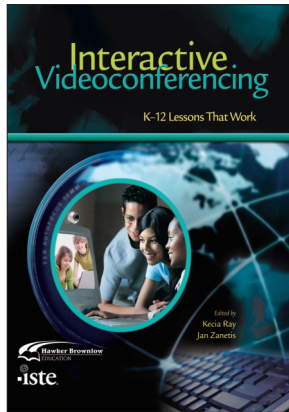


# Interactive Videoconferencing
