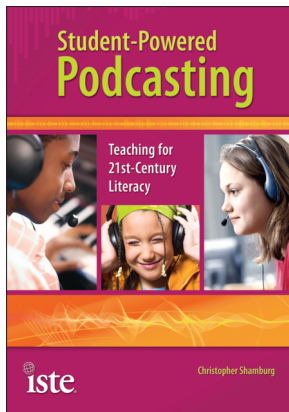


Student-Powered Podcasting
