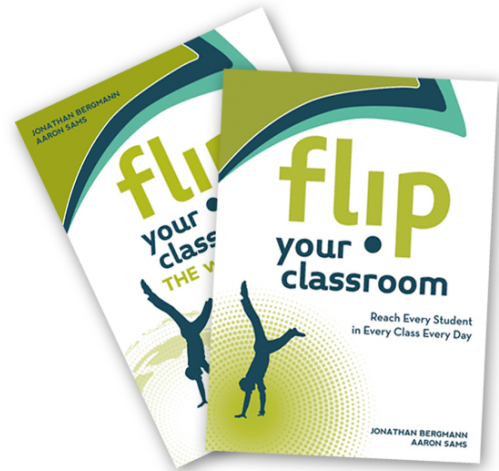

Summary

Bergmann and Sams found that their students demonstrated a deeper understanding of the material than ever before.
